

CAREER OPPORTUNITY: MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR

JOB PURPOSE:

The incumbent is responsible for maintenance activities for static and mechanical equipment throughout the assets through the execution of individual and team work plans in accordance with approved policies, procedures and guidelines.

- Develops maintenance plans and checklists for each of the major pieces of equipment
- Develops and tracks a maintenance schedule
